

PARENT GUIDE AND EXPECTATIONS

K—Year 2

1

Establish a routine to support your child's learning.

Set up a comfortable, quiet, shared space where your child can engage in the daily activities.

2

Use your child's unique **Home Learning Code** to access the **Seesaw** class app. When signing in with this code, students can 'like' their teacher's morning greeting (as required to gauge student attendance), post their work, respond to set activities/tasks and view class announcements. They do not see the work of any other student in the class. This is different to your Parent Access Code.

- To view set activities, touch the activities light bulb.

- To respond to a digital activity, click add response, the child then completes the work, press the tick to upload their work.

- To post a video, photo or drawing, be it relevant to the set work or a means of communication with the teacher, press the green 'add' button, select communication method, once completed upload using the tick.

Have conversations with your child to check for understanding.

Encourage independent learning and problem solving (where possible).

Teachers will post material in Seesaw by 8.45am each day.

Some tasks will not require screen time and as such we are reliant on parents/caregivers to enable these learning experiences.

Use emails to check for current updates from your child's teacher and information from the school.

If your child remains unsure of a set activity/task, they can contact their teachers using the Seesaw Class app as the communication platform. We ask parents to keep communication with the teacher (either from you or your child) to only as required.
