

Grace Christian School has a compulsory school uniform. School uniforms play an integral role in the life of the School by:

- Providing a sense of belonging to a community;
- Providing opportunity for individual development through correct grooming;
- Ensuring a practical, safe and modest standard of dress;
- Enabling the wider community to identify students as Grace students; and
- Restricting the potential for competition between, and comparisons being made by, students with regard to their attire.
- Reduces stress on both parents and student having to choose appropriate clothing for school wear.

The School reserves the right to alter or correct the Uniform Policy during the course of the school year. When doing so, the School will give reasonable notice of any change.

## General

- Uniform must be clean and in a good condition.
- Full uniform is to be worn, including when wearing uniform offsite.
- School shoes must be polished and in good condition.
- Approved Leavers Jackets may be worn all year by Year 12 students only.
- Presentation evening uniform includes ties for boys.
- PE uniform is worn all day on the day of PE lessons for primary. Secondary students may only wear PE uniform to school for first period PE classes but change to standard uniform following. Students with PE in the last period may wear the uniform home.
- Boys shirts may be out during Term 1 and 4, but tucked in during Term 2 and 3 with ties.
- Uniform items must be purchased from the Uniform Shop except for footwear. Items purchased elsewhere may not comply and may need to be replaced.

## Hairstyles

- All hair must be neatly styled and clean. Extreme styles or un-natural coloured hair is not acceptable.
- Hair touching the collar must be tied up (girls Pre-Kindy to Year 10) and must be cut (boys Pre-Kindy to Year 10).
- Year 11 & 12 girls may choose to wear their hair out if it poses no health and safety issues; boys must tie their hair up if it extends beyond the collar. Tied up hair must not extend beyond the collar.
- Only hair ties or bands that are discreet, black, white, navy or tartan are permitted.
- Students must be clean shaven.
- Sideburns must not extend below middle ears.
- Fringes must be kept out of the eyes and pinned back if necessary.

## Makeup

Year 11 & 12 girls:

- Natural looking make-up is permitted.
- No coloured nail polish, coloured lipsticks, eye shadow, glitter or eyeliner is permitted.
- Mascara must be subtle and look natural.
- All nails must look natural and be of a suitable length to engage in the school curriculum.
- False nails/eyelashes are not permitted.

All other students:

Make up is not permitted for students in Pre-Kindergarten to Year 10 and for boys in Year 11 and Year 12. However, girls in lower secondary may wear subtle foundation only.

## Jewellery

- A modest watch may be worn. Smart watches are not permitted.
- Girls may wear one plain silver or gold sleeper or stud in the earlobe only with the exception of Year 11 & 12 who may wear a second earring in each ear.
- Necklaces are only permitted for Year 11 & 12 students and must be simple small and with a Christian symbol.
- Maximum sleeper size must not exceed a 5 cent piece and studs 4mm in diameter.
- No other jewellery is acceptable except house bands and medic alerts.
- Body piercings other than ears are not permitted.
- Visible tattoos are not permitted.
- Sunglasses may be worn outside of classrooms.

## Casual/Free Dress Days

- Clothing is to be modest.
- Tight skin tops, singlets, halter neck tops or dresses or bare midriffs are not permitted.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh length or longer.
- Closed in footwear must be worn.

## Leavers Jackets

The leavers jackets must comply with school colours, meet uniform standards, be clean, well fitted and the design must be authorized by the School Executive Team. The year may be included in the design as too may a student's first name, surname or preferred name as indicated on the roll.

## Uniform Description

Uniform items must be purchased from the Uniform Shop except for footwear. Items purchased elsewhere may not comply and may need to be repurchased.
