School Photo Days

School photos will be held from 19 September to 21 September. Details on how to order photos through *photoworks* (our new school photographers) have been sent home to parents. The photo day schedule is available on the School Steam App.

Students may wear their sports uniform on the day prior to having their photo taken, to allow for uniforms to be cleaned and ironed.

Uniform to be worn:

Pre-Kindy to Pre-Primary - School Polo shirt and school denims (school zipped fleece jackets may be worn)

Junior Primary (Year 1 & Year 2) - School sports uniform (school jackets/jumpers may be worn)

Upper Primary (Year 3 to Year 6)

Girls: Skort or trousers with white school shirt | Boys: Trousers or shorts with white school shirt & tie (school jackets/jumpers may be worn)

Secondary (Year 7 to Year 11)

Girls: Skirt or trousers with school blouse | Boys: trousers or shorts with white school shirt and tie (school jackets/jumpers may be worn)

Secondary (Year 12)

Girls: Skirt or trousers with blouse and leavers jacket | Boys: trousers or shorts with shirt and tie and leavers jacket

Students involved in team sports photographs are to ensure they pack their sporting uniform (e.g. netball, soccer and sports uniform for interschool teams).
