At Grace Christian School, high standards of dress and grooming are essential, reflecting both personal pride and the values of our school community. The wearing of school uniform is compulsory and students are expected to follow the school's uniform and grooming guidelines, recognising that presentation is an outward reflection of respect and self-discipline.

The school uniform fosters a sense of belonging, creates a positive public identity, and ensures practical benefits such as cost-effectiveness for families and the reduction of status-based differences among students.

A key principle behind the school uniform is the value of modesty. Rather than focusing on personal expression through clothing, students are encouraged to embrace their identity within a supportive Christian community. Modesty is less about specific attire and more about an attitude of humility and respect for others.

Students are expected to wear the school uniform with pride, honour, and a positive attitude, understanding that it represents both personal and collective responsibility.

General Uniform Guidelines

- Uniforms must be clean and in good condition.
- Uniform standards must be maintained at all times, including when wearing the uniform outside of school hours or in the community. The uniform should not be worn with non-uniform items simultaneously.
- Sports uniform items should not be worn with formal uniform items.
- Hats are compulsory all year for students in Pre-Kindergarten to Year 6. Hats or navy/white caps are compulsory for students in Year 7 - 12 in Terms 1 and 4 when outdoors in direct sunlight, and strongly recommended during Terms 2 and 3.
- School shoes must be polished and in good condition.
- Primary students may wear their Physical Education (PE) uniform to school all day on the day of their PE lessons.
- Secondary boys may leave their shirts untucked during Terms 1 and 4, but must tuck them in during Terms 2 and 3 when ties must be worn. Note: Primary boys do not wear ties and may leave their shirts untucked.
- Secondary girls' skirts must not be shorter than a hand's width above the knee.
- Secondary students must wear their formal uniform to school and change into their PE uniform only for PE lessons and Dance and Drama lessons.

Exceptions: Students who have PE, Dance and Drama, or Outdoor Education in the last period may wear the PE uniform home.

Hairstyles

- All hair must be neatly styled and clean. Extreme styles, such as mullets, partial shaves, and mohawks, are not permitted. Unnatural hair colours that differ from a student's natural hair colour are not acceptable.
- Hair touching the collar must be tied up (girls Pre-Kindy to Year 10) and must be cut (boys Pre-Kindy to Year 10).
- Year 11 & 12 girls may choose to wear their hair out if it poses no health and safety issues.
- Year 11 & 12 boys must tie their hair up if it extends beyond the collar or have it cut.
- Only hair ties or bands that are discreet, black, white, navy or tartan are permitted.

- Students must be clean shaven.
- Sideburns must not extend below middle ears.
- Fringes must be kept out of the eyes

Makeup

Year 11 & 12 girls:

- Natural looking make-up is permitted.
- No coloured nail polish, coloured lipsticks, eye shadow, glitter or eyeliner is permitted.
- Mascara must be subtle and look natural.
- All nails must look natural and be of a suitable length to engage in the school curriculum.
- False nails/eyelashes are not permitted.

All other students:

Make up is not permitted for students in Pre-Kindergarten to Year 10 and for boys in Year 11 and Year 12. However, girls in lower secondary may wear subtle foundation only.

Jewellery

- A modest watch may be worn. Smart watches must be set to school, aeroplane or night mode during school hours.
- Girls may wear one sleeper or stud in the earlobe only with the exception of Year 11 & 12 where a second earring in each ear is permitted.
- Maximum sleeper size must not exceed a five cent piece and small stud style earrings must not exceed 4mm in diameter and may include coloured diamantes and shapes.
- Necklaces are only permitted for Year 11 & 12 students and must be simple, small and with a Christian symbol.
- No other jewellery is permitted, except for house bands and medic alert bracelets.
- Body piercings other than ear piercings are not permitted.
- Visible tattoos are not permitted.
- Sunglasses may be worn outside of classrooms.

Casual/Free Dress Days

- Clothing is to be modest.
- Skin tight tops, singlets, halter neck tops or dresses or bare midriffs are not permitted.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh length or longer.
- Closed in footwear must be worn.

Leavers Jackets

Leavers jackets must comply with school colours, meet uniform standards, be clean, well-fitted, and have a design authorised by the School Executive Team. The year may be included in the design, as may a student's first name, surname, or preferred name (as listed on the schools roll). Nicknames may be permitted at the discretion of the Head of Student Management. Leavers jackets may only be worn by Year 12 students.

Policy Updates

The School reserves the right to amend the Uniform Policy and Standards as needed. When doing so, the School will provide reasonable notice of any changes to ensure a smooth transition for students and families.
